


#### A MESSAGE FROM MRS WALSH



#### What is the A\*STARS Programme?



Throughout the year we take part in activities that encourage active travel and teach road safety. All children were involved in Walk to School Month (October) and will take part in other activities, depending on what year your child is in. In the Summer term we also have a Let's Walk Together event with the Junior School where we can meet and walk to school together.

Reception – Walking or Wheeling and Parent Road safety Walk

Year 1 – Walking or Wheeling, Road Safety and seatbelt and car seat safety when in the car.

Year 2 – Walking and Wheeling, Road Safety Quiz and Scooter safety



To keep our children safe we also ask parents to:

- Encourage walking to school (less cars on the road).
- Ask your child to hold your hand when crossing the road.
- Talk to your child about the road dangers.
- Involve your child in finding a safe place to cross.
- Talk about road signs and the meaning of car lights (orange, red, white).
- Park safely and considerately!
