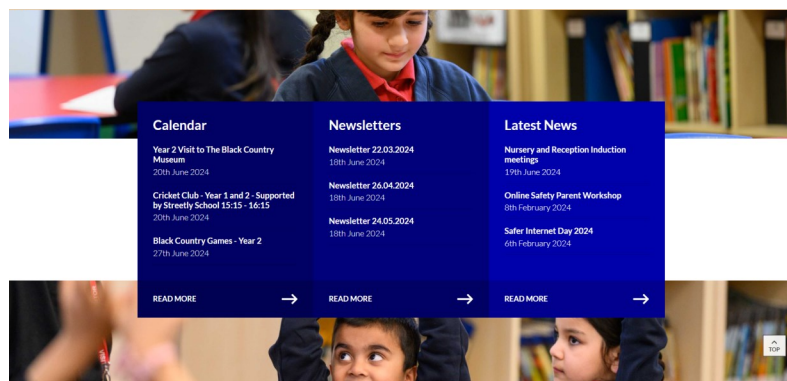

New School Website

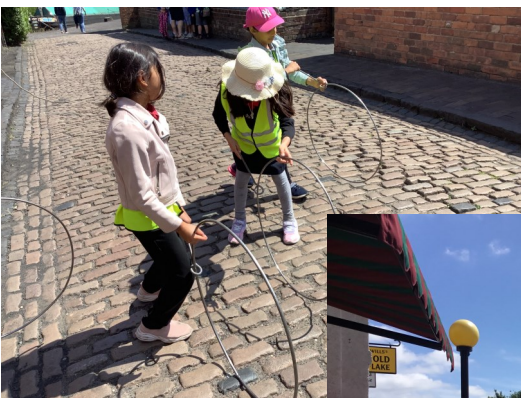
Our school website has been redesigned! We have some wonderful new photos of our children and lots of up-to-date information. Please take a look and let us have your thoughts.
